## In My Life This Week

**Monday.** Have you ever considered that there is something about your faith that you wish to pass on? Is there a lesson God has taught you over the years that might be not only for your benefit but also for someone else's? Read 2 Cor. 1:1-11 and consider the challenges and trials to your faith through the years and how and to whom you could pass them along...

**Tuesday.** Do you have trouble meeting with God on a regular, personal basis? Maybe you need a sacred space. Is there somewhere that you can regularly read God's Word, meditate on it, and pray without interruption? Maybe what you really need is a sacred space of time, one that you can make habitually your time with God. Consider what changes you need to make to suit yourself to meeting with God.

**Wednesday.** In 1996, Bill Hybels wrote the book "Becoming a Contagious Christian." One of the key aspects in someone else wanting to emulate your faith is you having a faith that is actually desirable. What is there about your walk with God that someone else would want for themselves? If you can think of nothing, then consider why you think so.

**Thursday.** On Sunday, we briefly looked at God's hesed, his faithful love, his covenant fulfilling love. Check out these references to get a broader picture of God's love for you and thank Him for its ultimate fulfillment in Jesus Christ: Neh. 9:13-18, Ps. 136 & Jonah 4:1-3.

**Friday–Saturday.** Pastor Tyler will be speaking on Psalms 42-43. Read and think through these Psalms as you prepare for our time of worship together.
